

About the Survey

- First year of community participation
- Includes students in grades 7-12
- 44% response rate for community (n=2,596)
- All participants had parent permission

How Can Parents and Other Adults Help?

21%

of the youth who have been drunk in the past 12 months, reported that they get the alcohol from their family. This was the largest single source.



Students who thought their parents would be more accepting of their substance use were **more likely** to use substances.

53%

of youth reported having talked to their parents about the dangers of substance use in the past 12 months.

Talking to your kids about the risks of substance use, even when you think they know them, is important!
